RULES & REGULATIONS

Due to changes in Health and Safety and Licensing Legislation, the Committee has implemented the following rules which, if not adhered to, may result in immediate closure of the rally and our operator's license being withdrawn.

TRACTORS - NO passengers unless proper seat fitted.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE TIMES

- No caravans / entrants will be admitted to the park before 9 am on FRIDAY.
- THURSDAY – No overnight parking on Thursday night for entrants or stall holders on site or on Scone Racecourse road or Rally Entrance road.
- FRIDAY – arrival 9 am - 8 pm (last entry to rally field or caravan site. Later entries will be redirected into car park overnight).
- SATURDAY – arrival 7 am - 8 pm (last entry to rally field or caravan site. Later entries will be redirected into car park overnight).
- SUNDAY – arrival, no vehicle, entrant or otherwise will be admitted to the rally field after 10 am.
- MONDAY – departure. ALL ENTRANTS and STALL HOLDERS to leave Rally Field by 11 am.

CAMPSITES

- Campsite pass entitles entrant with caravan / camper / tent entry to caravan areas only. A nominal fee of £15.00 is charged for campsite accommodation for the weekend. Anyone staying overnight on site (including in a vehicle) must purchase a Campsite Pass.
- If campers wish to camp next to friends (site spaces cannot be reserved) all tents/caravans must enter the rally together. Groups can congregate in the car park field prior to entering the parklands.
- Tents / Marquees / Stands must meet Fire Legislation requirements.
- Caravans / tents will be allocated a space by steward with a 6 metre gap between each caravan / tent (side to side), 2 metres end to end.
- No parking of caravans / tents / lorries, etc on the bank of the river or under trees for safety reasons - please adhere to taped off areas.
- Fire extinguisher stations in campsite must not be obstructed.
- Gas cylinders - 2 gas cylinders per caravan / tent (i.e. one on, one spare).
- Generators - no portable petrol generators allowed in areas open to the public.
- All generators must be switched off between **11 pm – 7 am** with exception of marquee and catering vans.
- No open fires. BBQs and fire pits, etc, must be in appropriate containers and must be extinguished when unattended. Self made fires on the ground will be extinguished.

GENERAL

- All drivers must have the licence, tax and insurance relevant to the vehicle - as this is a public event, any breach will be an offence under the Road Traffic Act (this includes mini motorbikes and quads). No unnecessary movement of vehicles on field. No underage driving.
- SVTEC Club insurance only covers stationary engines & Static horticultural entries. Tractors, cars motorbikes, etc require separate insurance
- **Only one person per tractor unless two seats provided (this will be strictly monitored)**
- Any entrant gaining access to the caravan site and rally, receiving an attendance plaque but with no entry being present will have their details recorded and this may result in future entries being refused.
- Please place all vehicles and caravans on site before booking in.
- Vehicles entered on Club stands must NOT be entered as an individual.
- Fire breaks & Fire Points must be kept clear at all times for the duration of the event.
- Entrants must have insurance to cover them on the field and may be asked to show this at rally.
- Individual entries must be manufactured before 1990. Vehicle Clubs may include newer vehicles.
- Abuse of volunteers / security staff will not be tolerated and will result in expulsion from the Rally Field and a ban on future entries.
